Our Grant Committee is looking to award grants for creative programs and or equipment that is needed to run a pilot project that enhances and supports the educational experiences for ALL students. Special Consideration will be given to integrated activities that focus on collaboration of General Education Students and Special Education Students.

What are some examples of past SEPTA Grants?

Kindness Corner - Mrs. Long's classroom at Locust includes a character education rug, decorations, and beanbag chairs for students.

The Green Team - Supplies to implement a school wide recycling program led by students at Locust School.

The Pairs Program - Games and Supplies for an inclusive game and socialization lunch period at the high school.

The Smoothie Cart - Equipment and supplies for students to work on job ready skills while creating Smoothies.

Flexible Seating Project - Standing tables, low tables and flower tables to create a more collaborative classroom at Stratford in Ms. Medonis and Mrs. Albig's room.

Who can apply?

Teachers that work with special education students (i.e: special education and general education teachers, P.E. teachers, art teachers, librarians, social workers, school psychologists, speech therapists etc.). One teacher or a group of teachers can apply.

When can I apply?
